Dear Mr. Galluzzo,

Thank you for again using my consultancy services in the selection and purchase of the Stratum filly from Spinner's Magic (NZ) at the recent Classic Yearling Sale.

This lovely chestnut is a strong, athletic individual from a very successful female line. She has a lot of length and is very much the racehorse type.

Stratum, sire of the filly, is one of the best racing sons of twice champion Australian sire Redoute's Choice, and with his first runners last season was overall champion sire of two-year-olds as well as the leading first season sire with the Golden Slipper winner Crystal Lily his crowning achievement. I think he has so far been represented by five individual stakes winners.

Your filly is the first foal of her dam Spinner's Magic (NZ), a good Sydney winner who twice placed at Group 3 level in Sydney and she is a daughter of champion New Zealand sire O'Reilly who although still relatively young is proving an outstanding sire of broodmare. Mares by O'Reilly have already produced eleven stakes winners (6.6% of their runners) and they have a high winners-to-runners ratio of 65.3%.

Australian Oaks winner Daffodil is to date the best winner produced by an O'Reilly mare and others include The Pooka, Sound Journey, Tootsie and Icepin.

I should also note that outstanding sires Twig Moss (Fr) and Wilkes (Fr) are the sires of the second and third dams of your filly and certainly strengthen her pedigree.

Best of luck to your syndicate with this lovely filly – hope she will be very successful on the track and provide lots of fun for her owners.
