At the request of Mr. Frank Galluzzo of Supreme Syndications, I have examined the above filly at Bowral on the 31st October 2018. The examination was limited to a clinical examination, assessment of conformation, and a videoscope examination.

At the time of examination, the filly was in good health and condition and free from signs of disease. No abnormalities were detected on auscultation of the heart and lungs, and the Cardinal signs were within normal limits.

Her body and leg conformation was within normal limits, in fact she has, in my opinion, an athletic well-proportioned body. There were no signs of lameness when led at the walk.

Video Endoscope examination was performed with the Videoscope introduced through the Right nostril. There were no visible anatomical or pathological abnormalities visible at the time of examination. There was full and sustained abduction of both Arytenoid Cartilages, satisfying the condition of **Lane Grade 1**.

Within the limits of the examination there were no abnormalities present that would in my opinion prevent the chances of this horse withstanding the pressures of racing. In my opinion the filly is a suitable subject for syndication/sale as a racehorse.
