At the request of Mr Frank Galluzzo of Supreme Syndications, Bluegrass Bloodstock has provided the following written valuation below for the yearling colt by Star Witness/My Cherie.

It must be noted that this valuation has been provided sight unseen, but we have taken into account the veterinary certificate provided by Silver Pines Veterinary Clinic on the 8/06/2021, which states that the Star Witness colt is in good health and condition, body and leg conformation is within normal limits, he has a grade 1 scope. His radiographs taken displayed no major abnormalities for his future as a racehorse.

It also must be noted that Bluegrass Bloodstock doesn't have any financial interest in this particular Star Witness colt, and this valuation has been provided for the purpose of syndication.

In the photo and veterinary certificate provided the Star Witness colt is well grown, he's a powerful colt in the pic, with a healthy coat and eye.

His sire Star Witness stands at Widden Stud, and at the year of conception in 2018, he stood for the service fee of \$33,000 AUD.

At the yearling sales in 2021, Star Witness has had 47 yearlings sell at public auction, for an average of \$68,425 AUD.

Star Witness was a high-class sprinter, who showed precocity and speed winning the Group 1 Blue Diamond at 2yrs and the Group 1 Coolmore Stud at 3yrs.

At stud, Star Witness would be considered a commercial stallion who has sired 19 individual stakes winners and his progeny have won over 46 million in prize money. His headline horse is the group 1 winner Global Glamour.

The dam of this Star Witness colt is My Cherie by Choisir, she was a very promising horse, winning 2 races from only 4 career starts before being retired. My Cherie won both her starts at Canterbury over 1100m and 1200m, her other 2 starts she placed at Rosehill and Canterbury. She is by Choisir, and her 2nd dam Annisa Kahira is a $\frac{1}{4}$ sister to Super Impressive, winner of 11 races, he was a multiple group winner and was also group 1 placed. Annisa Kahira is also a half sister to Unrocel Saint who was a listed winner and group placed.

At stud Garnet Rose is the dam of 6 live foals, 3 have raced for 1 winner. Star Cherie the full sister to the Star Witness colt is showing good promise, she's had only 3 starts winning her maiden at Gosford and also being placed at Gosford.

I understand the Star Witness colt has successfully completed his breaking in.

When valuing the Star Witness/My Cherie yearling colt, Bluegrass Bloodstock has considered his pedigree, in which his full sister is showing good promise on the racetrack and veterinary certificate which states he is in good health, well grown with sound conformation, including grade 1 scope and no major abnormalities on radiograph. Bluegrass has also considered that the Star Witness yearlings have averaged \$68,425 at public auction in 2021. It is in Bluegrass Bloodstock professional opinion that the yearling Star Witness/My Cherie colt would have the present value of between \$75,000 to \$85,000 AUD.
